Dr. Stanley M. Shaw joined the faculty of Purdue University in 1962 and has been a pioneer in the fields of Bionucleonics and Nuclear Pharmacy. Over his illustrious career, Dr. Shaw has been actively involved in the areas of nuclear pharmacy education, research and service. In 1972, a series of courses in nuclear pharmacy were added to the Purdue pharmacy curriculum, while Dr. Shaw tirelessly worked to bring recognition of nuclear pharmacy by both educational and professional organizations. In 1975, The Section on Nuclear Pharmacy was formed in the American Pharmaceutical Association and recognition of nuclear pharmacy as the first specialty area of pharmacy practice followed, thanks in part to Dr. Shaw's dedication and determination.

To celebrate Dr. Shaw's career and the history path taken in the development of the specialty area of nuclear pharmacy, the Division of Nuclear Pharmacy will be hosting a series of continuing education sessions on Saturday, October 29th. These sessions will highlight the changes that have taken place in various areas of nuclear pharmacy practice, as well as current and future developments in each of the areas. Kicking off the educational series will be a keynote session offered by Dr. Shaw himself, discussing important moments and events in his career along with his perspective of where the specialty is heading in the future.
